

RTC/ LODEN SEED PROGRAMME

(Student Empowerment through Entrepreneurship Development)

Loden Foundation has contributed a seed capital of Nu 50,000 to RTC. SEED is an extension of the Loden Entrepreneurship Programme to colleges and schools, in order to bring both theoretical and learning and practical experience of social entrepreneurship to the young minds.

The college invites interested students from various departments to submit their Business plans to the Committee. The Committee comprises of Faculty members from different departments who will be responsible for screening the Business plans and awarding the SEED capital to the most deserved group.

Selection Criteria

1. The Students should have a proper Business Plan format.
2. Feasibility of the Business.

Terms and Conditions

1. Student group should have a proper mix of students from various years in order to maintain the continuity of the project. For e.g. if the project is initiated by third year students, then they need to have students from second years or first. The group shall comprise of at least 7 people (30% girls) will present their business plan to the Committee, who will be responsible for screening the business plan.
2. If the 50,000 SEED capital is not sufficient then students can make contributions from their side. An addition of 50,000 will be the maximum capital student can invest in their project i.e. 100000 is the maximum students can invest in their project.
3. The student group should start their business project within the college campus.
4. The student group shall repay the entire capital to the management within 1 year from the commencement of the business.
5. The student groups are expected to keep proper records of sales, marketing, accounting, and any information related to the business.
6. The capital will be sanctioned based on the requirement of the business.
