expenditure, and other personal expenditure, whereas, self-funded would require you to pay all the above yourself. You must submit a written agreement to pay the costs associated with any of the categories you checked "yes" to in Section D *(please refer to the Consent Letter on the RTC intranet)*. This agreement should be signed by the person (parent/ guardian) responsible for these costs.
